Noun(으)로

(으)로 expresses a direction (toward a place). It means "to" or "toward" in English.

When the preceding vowel ends with a vowel or ㄹ, then 로 is used.

When it ends in a consonant 으로 is used. It is also used when expressing a means of transport, other means, such as tools, and materials used to make something.

In English this corresponds to "by" or "with/using" and "from".
