NOUN **밖에**

밖에 expresses the only thing or option available., with no possibility of anything else. English = "only" or "nothing but." The word that comes before 밖에 has the connotation of being very small or few in number, and a negative form must follow it. 밖에 goes with certain verbs that have a negative meaning such as 없다, 안, 못 and 모르다. Although 밖에 is followed by negative words, it cannot be followed by 아니다 or any positive, imperative or propositive form.
